HUGE TURNOUT FOR YEAR 6 ATP EXAM

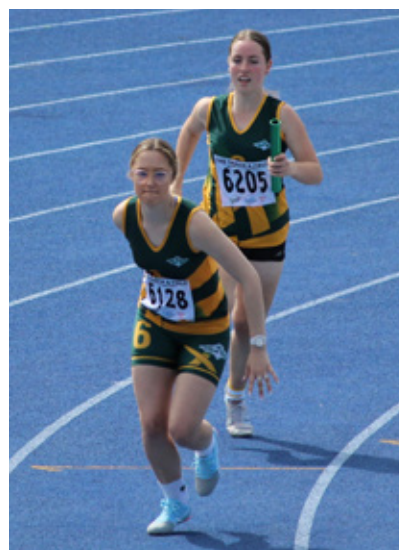
On the afternoon of Monday 17 September, over sixty Year 6 students took part in our annual Academic Talent Pathway exam.
